



## Declaration of Conformity

### REGULATION (US) California Proposition 65 Act

Last Updated: December 2025

The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Health and Safety Code section 25249.5 et seq.), also known as Proposition 65 is a list of chemicals known to the State to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity within the meaning of the Act (Health and Safety Code section 25249.8). The list is published in Title 27, California Code of Regulations, section 27001.

Cliff Electronic Components Limited confirms that their products and packaging fulfil the requirements of the act, last updated on December the 8th 2025.

Some copper alloys, such as brass, are used in various product groups including Feedthroughs, Connectors and Terminals for example and may contain Lead (CAS number 7439-92-1) up to, but not exceeding 4% as is permitted under the EU RoHS Directive, through exemption 6 (c) listed in Annex III.

As this is fully encapsulated into the finished part, it cannot migrate or diffuse from the products, thus preventing the risks of human contact or release into the environment.
